

PARTIAL TRUE STATEMENTS.

1. What Is a Partially True Statement?

It is a sentence in which some of the information is true, but part of it is false. In the picture description section, each statement describes part of the picture. It mentions something that you can see in the picture. However, it may also mention something that is not in the picture. Often, one thing is true but the rest is not.

2. Studying a Picture

Look at each picture carefully. What can you see in the picture? Think about how you would describe the picture. Identify all the people, locations, and objects in it. What other words can you think of for the picture? In your mind, think of possible sentences for the picture. Then analyze the answer choices.

- > **People:** a man
- Locations:** street, outdoors
- Objects:** ATMs, backpack
- Other:** a sunny day

True: We see a man and a bank.

False: He is inside. In fact he is **outside**.

True: We can see ATMs.

False: There are 4. We see only **3**.

True: The man has a backpack.

False: He is looking in it. It is **on his back**.

True: We see a man standing at an ATM.

False: There is no false information.
