Girl: I'm scanning an old photo.

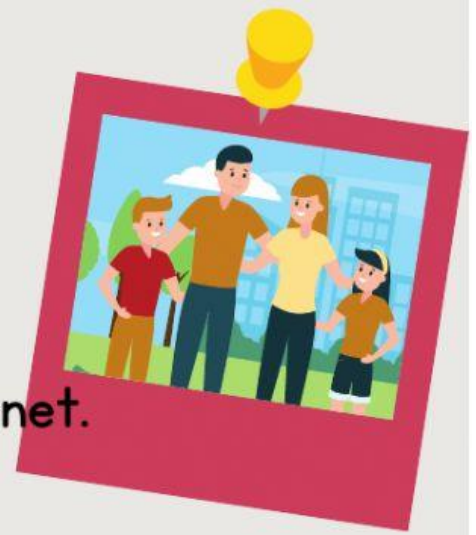
Boy: Really? Why?

What are you doing?

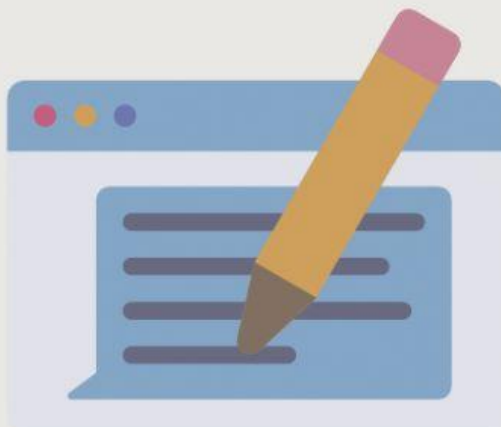
Boy: I'm posting a comment on Facebook.
