The energy stored when repelling poles are pushed closer together or when attracting poles are pulled further apart.

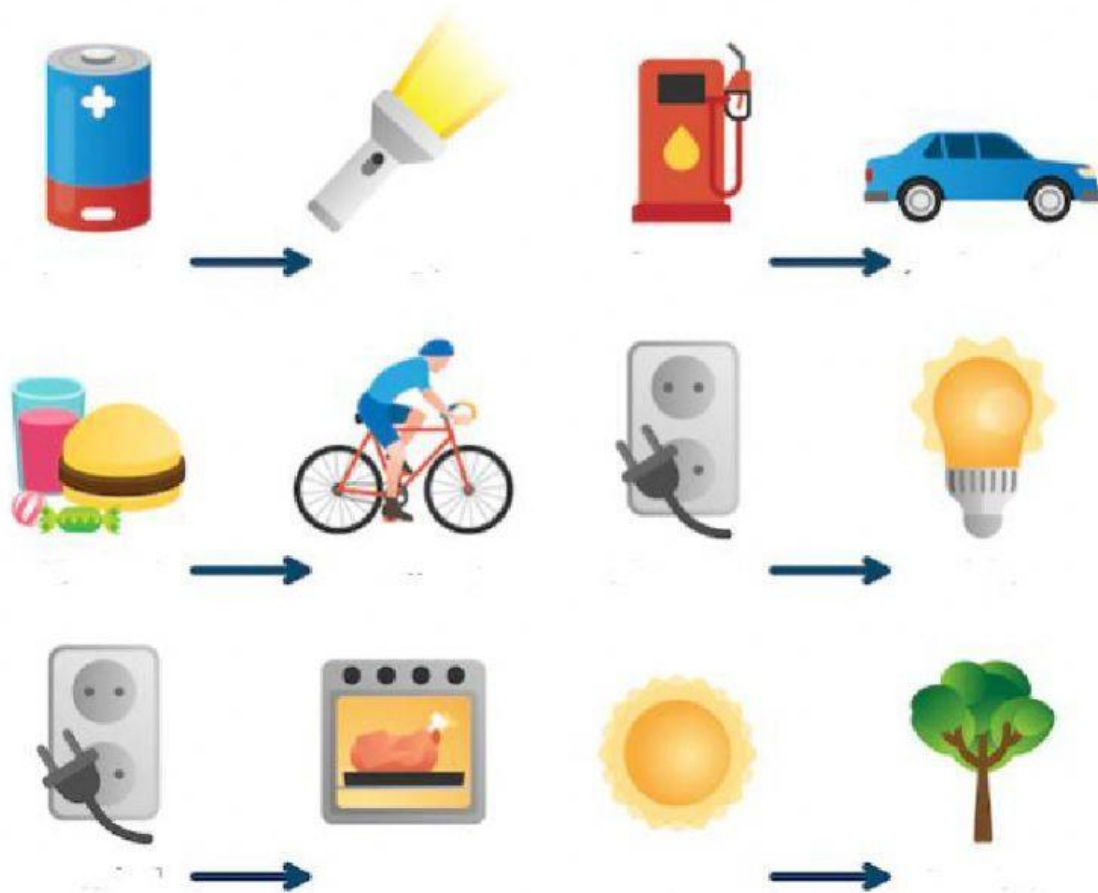
The total kinetic and potential energy of the particles in an object.
