REMEMBER THE RULE FOR THE SUPERLATIVE FORM

COMPARATIVES	SUPERLATIVES
-To compare 2 things	-To compare 3 things
Adjective (short)+ er + than	the + adjective (short) + est
For example: Homer is older than Maggie.	For example: Homer is the oldest in the family.
Homero es más viejo que Maggie.	Homero es el más viejo de la familia.

For example:
THE + FUNNY + EST → _____ FUNNI _____
