e.g. I talk → he talks

I drive → she drives

-es

Verbs ending in

-ss, -x, -sh, -ch, -o

e.g. I fix → she fixes

I do → it does

-ies

Verbs ending in

Consonant + **y**

e.g. I tidy → he tidies

but I play → he plays

	3 rd	He doesn't sing She doesn't sing It doesn't sing
P l u r a l	1 st	We don't sing
	2 nd	You don't sing
	3 rd	They don't sing

Personal Pronoun + don't + verb

Third person singular:

Personal Pronoun + doesn't + verb

Interrogative

S i n g u l a r	1 st	Do I sing?
	2 nd	Do you sing?
	3 rd	Does he sing? Does she sing? Does it sing?
P l u r a l	1 st	Do we sing?
	2 nd	Do you sing?
	3 rd	Do they sing?
