refundable	adj	if an amount of money is refundable, it can be given back to the person who paid it	Your purchase is refundable if the item you bought was faulty.	refund; refunding
security	n	the protection of a person, building, organization, or country	The broken windows are a threat to the security of the building.	secure; secured; securely
to require	v	to need something	All the rooms in the house require new furniture.	requirement; required

unfurnished	adj	having no furniture	The unfurnished house seemed empty and uninviting.	-
updated	v	changed to reflect the most recent information or style.	The class timetable will be updated if changes are necessary.	update
wing	n	a part of a large building that sticks out from the main part	The west wing was added to the hospital in 2015.	-

Expressions:

to assemble	to put together the different parts of something e.g., a bookcase / set of shelves
to be located	to be in a certain place e.g., "The library is located next to the theater."
to clean the easy chair	to clean a large, comfortable chair e.g., an armchair
to clear the coffee table	to remove items such as cups, plates, books, etc. from a low table in a living room
to dust the end table	to use a cloth to remove dust from a small table usually located next to an armchair
to switch the lamp on or off	to turn on or off a device which gives light and is usually located on a table or desk
to take out the garbage	to take garbage to a container outside your house from where it will be collected
to tidy the bookcase	to arrange books neatly in a bookcase
to vacuum the carpets	to use a vacuum cleaner (a device that sucks up dust and dirt) to clean a floor covering
to water the plants	to give plants in a pot or garden some water
