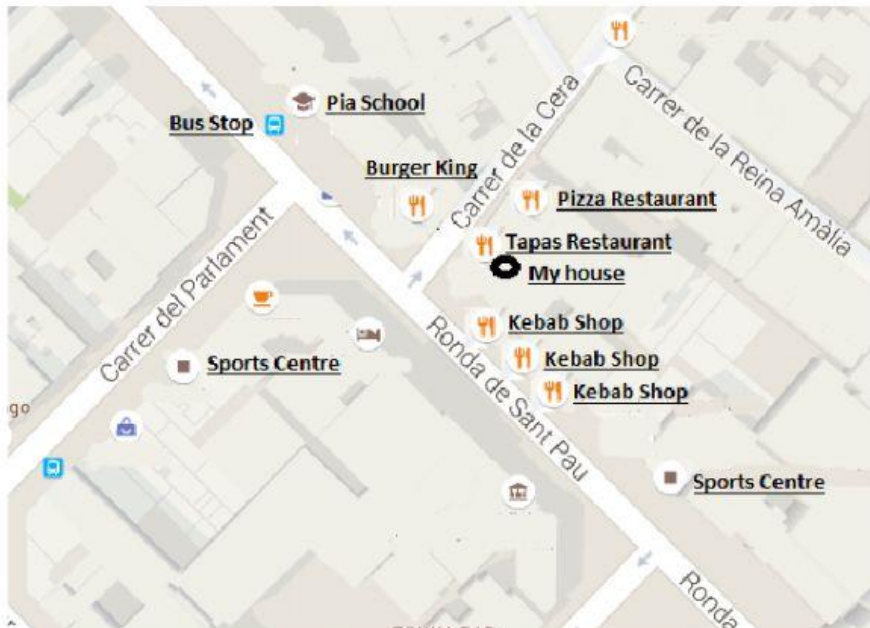

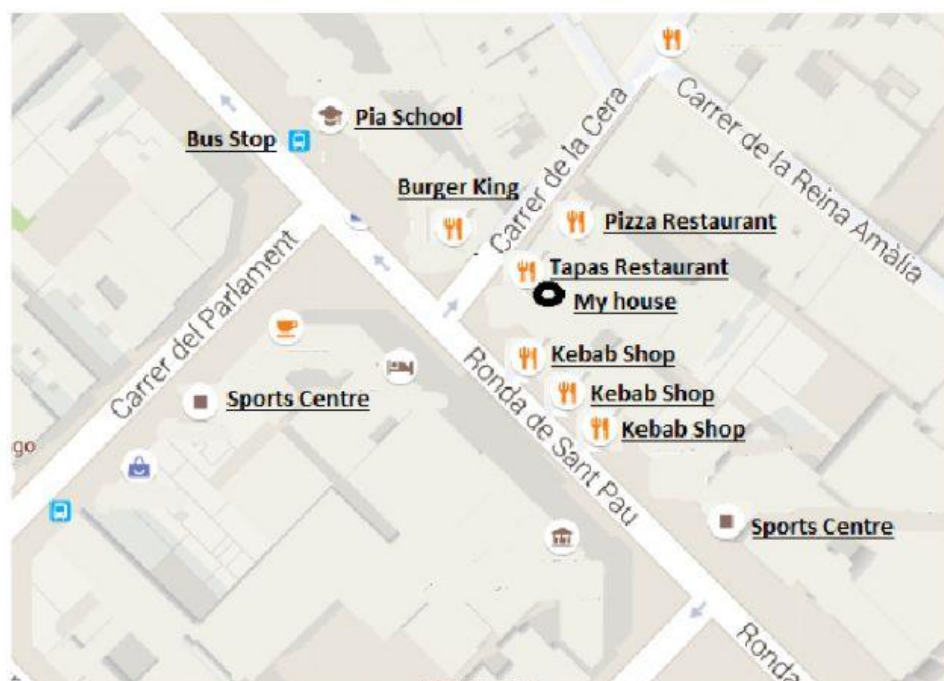
2. Reading comprehension
