Performer	Percussion instruments played with drumsticks or your hands.
Violin	Golden brass instrument with three valves. Popular in jazz music.
Cello	Long woodwind instrument with holes stopped by keys.
Clarinet	Long wind instrument with holes that are stopped by the fingers.
Drums	(noun) The person who plays music or acts for an audience.
Flute	A string instrument played with a bow, almost as big as an adult person.
Trumpet	A string instrument you must play on your shoulder.
Live concert	(verb) To play music or act for an audience.
Perform	A music show that is happening in real time. Not recorded.
Performance	A small group of people who play music together, usually popular music.
Orchestra	The platform where performers play music or act.
Band	A big group of people playing music, including different types of instruments.
Stage	The person who follows the work of an artist.
Fan	(noun) an act of playing music or acting a theatre play.
Lyrics	A short film made to advertise a song or album.
Recording	The sequence of notes of a music theme. Melody.
Songwriter	The words written for a song.
Studio	The pace, speed or rhythm.
Tempo	Composer. The person who writes music themes with words.
Tune	The place equipped with electronic devices to record music.
Video clip	The object where music or words are recorded, encoded.
