

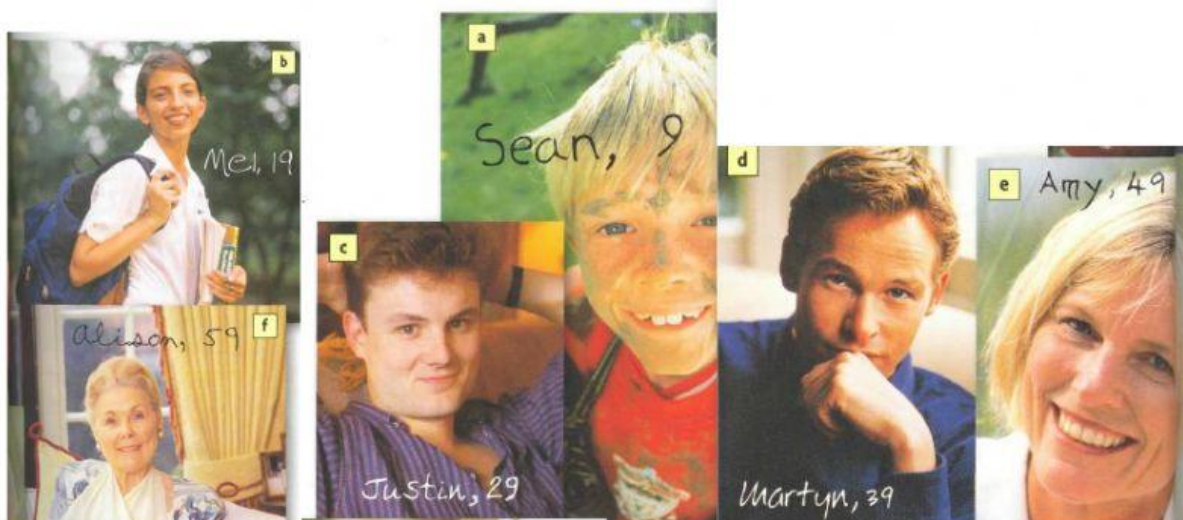

## Like doing & Would like to do

### Конструкції like doing та would like to do

Конструкція **like doing (love doing)** виражає загальне почуття задоволення від виконаної діяльності.

**I like reading.** Мені подобається читати.

Конструкція **would like to do (would love to do)** виражає бажання щось зробити у момент мовлення або у найближчому майбутньому.

**I would like to read.** Мені б хотілось почитати.

### Короткі відповіді:

**Would you like to dance?**  
**Yes, I would./ Yes, I'd love to.**

**Would you like to come for a walk?**  
**Yes, I would./ No, thank you.**

Потрібно зауважити, що **No, I wouldn't** зазвичай не використовується, оскільки вважається неввічливою відповіддю.
