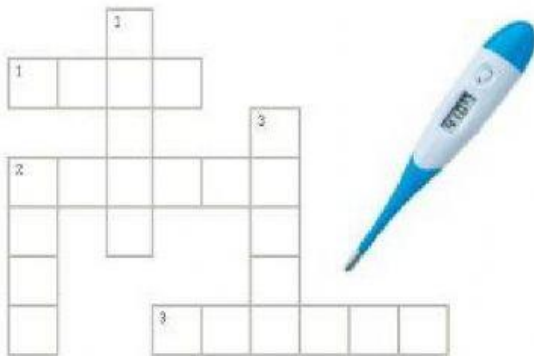

LESSON 4

PRESENT PERFECT PROGRESSIVE (INTERROGATIVE)

We form questions in the present perfect progressive by inverting the position of the auxiliary *have* and the subject for *Yes / No* questions. In *Wh-* questions we place the *Wh-* word at the beginning of the interrogative sentence.

- Have you been studying lately?
- How long has he been living in Peru?
- What have you been doing lately?
