

QUESTION TAGS

A question tag is a short question at the end of a statement. It's used when asking for agreement or confirmation.

Examples:

You are a student, aren't you?

She didn't understand the question, did she?

John has passed the exam, hasn't he?

STRUCTURE

Positive statement + negative question tag. (aux not 😊 ?)	Negative statement + positive question tag. (aux 😊 ?)
• They are tired, aren't they? • She works in an office, doesn't she? • We've got a small flat, haven't we? • Bill enjoyed the film, didn't he? • She can swim very well, can't she? • I am late, aren't I?	• They aren't here, are they? • He doesn't like the office, does he? • We have never seen the film, have we? • Nobody left a message, did they? • My sister can't drive, can she? • I'm not late, am I?
