<p>Responsible for safety regulation of inland water carriers</p> 	<p>When fighting small fires, workers are encouraged to follow this sequence</p> 
<p>When using this emergency device, the operator should ensure that there is an escape route behind them</p> 	<p>Even a short fall from this can cause serious injury</p> 
<p>Primary federal agency devoted to workplace safety</p> 	<p>Information signs are in this color</p> 
<p>They are required to create and maintain a safe and healthy workplace - including providing training, PPE, safety equipment and hazard communication</p> 	<p>This secures a trailer to the building and uses a system of lights to indicate that the trailer is safe to enter or not</p> 
<p>They have a strong vested interest in preserving a safe work environment, and must keep their own work areas well-organized, clean and free of clutter</p> 	<p>Federal agency that develops and enforces regulations protecting the land, air and water</p>
