Past simple: regular verbs.



We use the past simple for **finished actions** that happened in the past.

We use **did** and **did not (didn't)** as auxiliary verbs

Did	I / you / he / she / it / we / they	<b>work</b> yesterday?	Yes,	I / you / he / she / it / we / they	<b>did.</b>	No,	I / you / he / she / it / we / they <b>didn't.</b>





Regular verbs in the past simple form end with -ed

infinitive	past	spelling
watch	watch <b>ed</b>	add -ed
play	play <b>ed</b>	
arrive	arriv <b>ed</b>	add -d
study	stud <b>ied</b>	consonant + y: <del>y</del> -ied
stop	stop <b>ped</b>	one vowel + one consonant: double consonant + -ed
