
ADD "MORE" BEFORE LONG

We use "than" after comparative adjectives.

E.g.: The new house is bigger than the old house.

ADD "MOST" BEFORE LONG ADJECTIVES



interesting →

We use "the" before superlative adjectives.

E.g.: July is the coldest month of the year.
