Before we start with the write practice, let's review what is the simple past!

The simple past is the form of a verb used to describe an action that happened before the present time and is no longer happening.



We use the past tense to talk about:



1

Something that happened **once in the past**:

- I **met** my husband in 1995
- They **went** to the cinema
- They **got** home very early last night

2

Something that happened **several times in the past**:

- when I was a boy, I **walked** a mile to school every day.
- we **swam** a lot while we were on holiday.
- They always **enjoyed** visiting their friends.

3

Something that was **true for some time in the past**:

- I **lived** abroad for ten years.
- He **enjoyed** being a student
- She **played** a lot of tennis when she was younger

4

we often use **expressions with ago** with the past simple:

- I **met** my wife **a long time ago**.

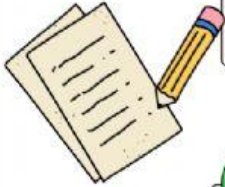
