The term absolutism refers to a **sole** person holding all of the power. It could relate to many different areas such as politics, truth and the monarchy. This is not an **exhaustive** list. In politics, the term means that one party has power over everyone. Absolutism, in terms of the truth, refers to a thought being absolutely true or absolutely false. An absolute monarchy means that a certain ruler has the power to freely govern its land with no **opposition**.
