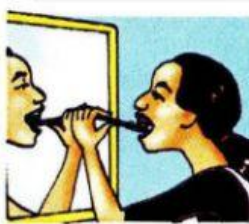

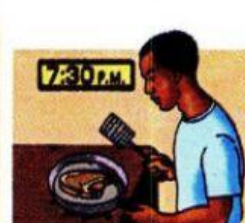

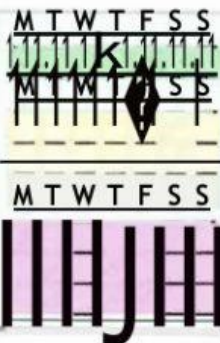

Don't say: Who wash the dishes?

Don't use do or does when who is the subject.

Don't say: Who Elees wash the dishes?
