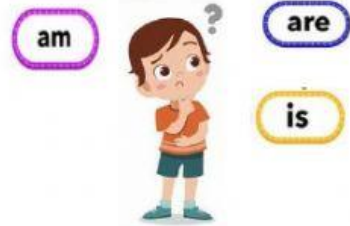


Verb To Be
