In the 1990s, the European Institute of Underwater Archaeology (IEASM) received permission to work in the a certain part of Egypt. During the five years of the expedition, they ____ (1) explore the area carefully. Then the team of archaeologists announced on 25 October 1998 the discovery of the palace of the Egyptian Queen Cleopatra (51-30 B.C.).
