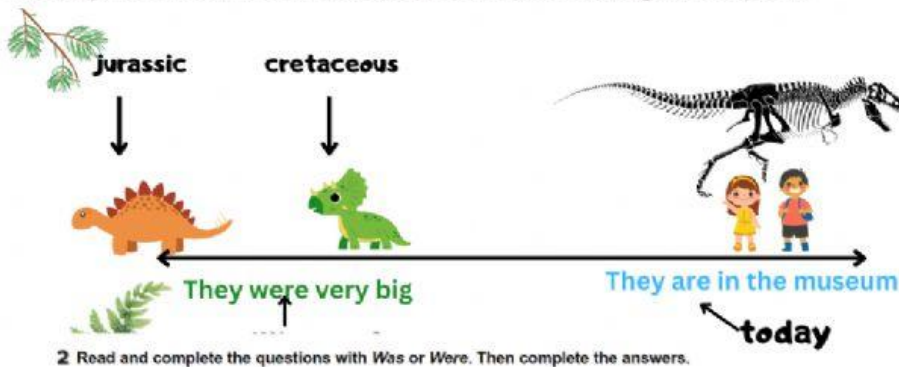


Past Simple of Be

The past simple describes events at any time in the past, from yesterday to millions of years ago. Be has two past simple forms. We use *was/wasn't* with I, he, she and it. We use *were/weren't* with you, we and they. You takes the same form (*were/weren't*) in both singular and plural.
