Get on your bikes and ride!

Do you like bike riding (ride)? Well, you're in good company! There are millions of bike riders in the U.S. Some of them hope ¹ (become) sports stars, but others just want ² (do) some exercise or have fun. Some people love ³ (ride) in big groups. Others don't mind ⁴ (be) alone. A lot of people ride very well, but some people have bad habits. They enjoy ⁵ (listen) to music when they ride, for example, or they like ⁶ (chat) to friends and they forget ⁷ (watch) the road! Are you one of them? Well, read our Rules for bike riders before you get on your bike and ride!

Rules for bike riders

- Road rules aren't just for cars and buses. Your bike is a form of transportation too, and you **mustn't / don't have to** forget that!
- You ¹ **mustn't / don't have to** go through a red light. You ² **don't have to / mustn't** ride on the sidewalk. You ³ **must / mustn't** stay on the road, and you ⁴ **mustn't / don't have to** ride in the wrong direction. And you ⁵ **mustn't / don't have to** listen to music or use a phone when you ride!
- Bike riders over 18 ⁶ **mustn't / don't have to** wear a helmet, but they're a very good idea. Use your head and don't forget your helmet! You ⁷ **mustn't / don't have to** wear expensive bike clothes, but you ⁸ **must / mustn't** be visible on the road, so try to wear bright colors.
