<i>Do you have a spare roll of insulating tape? Yes, I do./No, I don't.</i>	<i>Does Alex have a three-core cable? Yes, he does./No, he doesn't.</i>	<i>Can I borrow your drill? Yes, of course./No, I'm sorry. I'm using it.</i>
Do you have...? <i>Tenés...?</i> Yes, I do No, I don't	Does Alex have...? <i>Tiene Alex...?</i> Yes, he does No, he doesn't Esta pregunta, a diferencia de la primera, es que está en tercera persona. Con los pronombres he, she, it, se usa el auxiliar DOES. Por lo tanto, también se responde con DOES o DOESN'T. Como puede observarse, en la pregunta no está el pronombre "he", pero el nombre "Alex" nos da a entender que hablamos de "él".	Can I borrow your drill? <i>Puedo tomar prestado tu taladro?</i> Yes, of course No, I'm sorry. I'm using it. El verbo "borrow" siempre se usa con el pronombre "I" (yo). Can I borrow....?
Los verbos auxiliares DO y DOES (don't y doesn't en negativo) se utilizan en Inglés para marcar el tiempo verbal. Por lo tanto si hay preguntas o respuestas con estos auxiliares, significa que están en el tiempo PRESENTE .
