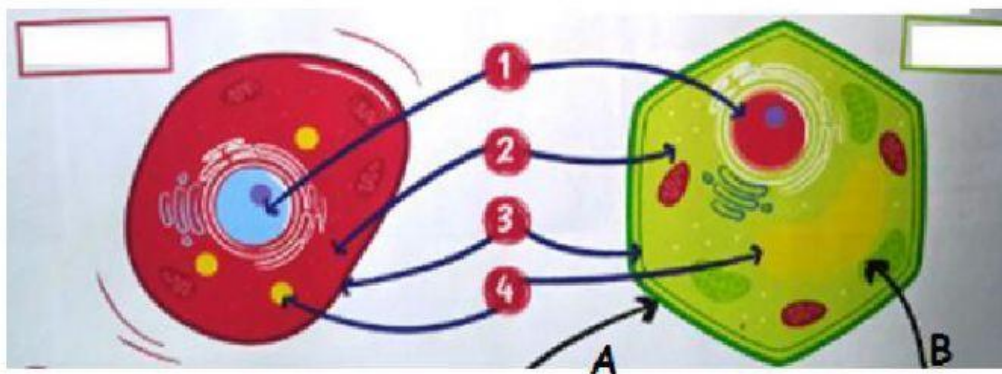




1. _____ : controls what happens inside the cell and contains all the genetic information.
