A noun which gives a common name to a person, place or thing is called a **common noun**.

The words temple, city, country, school, man, television, festival, month, day, river, newspaper, mountain, book, library are all common nouns.

A noun which names a particular person, place or thing is called a **proper noun**. It always begins with a capital letter wherever they appear in the sentence.

The words Pashupatinath, Kathmandu, Nepal, Triyog High School, Siddharth, Sony, Dashain, January, Saturday, Karnali, The Himalayan Times, Sagarmatha, Because of Winn-Dixie are all proper nouns.
