Most verbs: Add -ed	Verb ends in -e: Add only -d	Verb ends in Consonant + Y: Take off the Y + -ied	Verb ends in C + V + C: Double the last consonant + ed

Attention!!!
If the verb ends in **Vowel + Y**,
you **just add -ed**:

play - play**ed**
enjoy - enjoy**ed**

This rule usually
applies to **short
verbs** (= with
only 1 syllable).
