

Definition of Plot

Plot is the story line.

The plot is broken down in **5** parts.

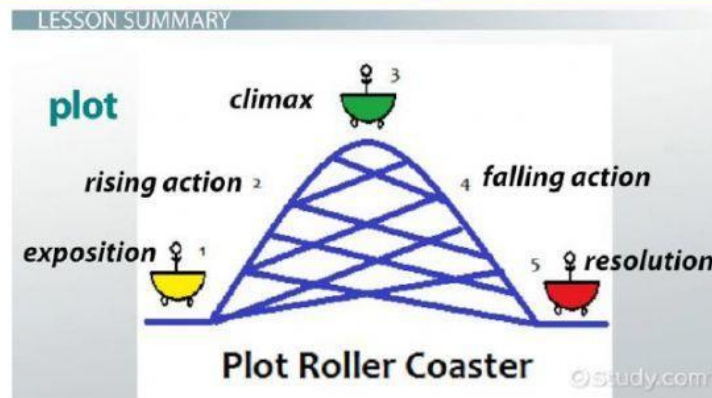
The first part of the plot is the **exposition**. Another word for exposition in the **beginning**. In the beginning you will have the **setting** and the **characters**.

The second part is the **rising action**. This is where the conflict is found. The main character encounter some problems.

The third part of the plot is the **climax**. This is the exciting part.

The fourth part is the **falling action**.

The fifth part is the **resolution**. This is where the story is solved.
