They are multicellular but microscopic. They feed on the remains of living things and on the decomposing matter.

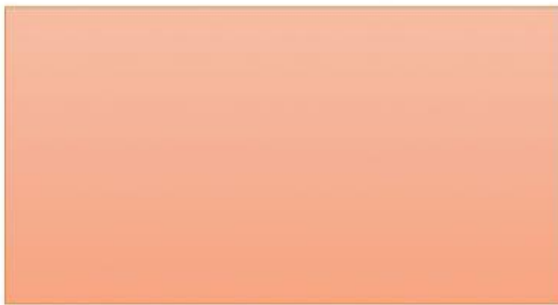
They are unicellular and microscopic. They are used in food industry to produce bread, cheese and wine.
