‘On **Saturday mornings** I usually get up late and do the housework. Then I meet some friends in town for lunch, and go shopping in the afternoon.’

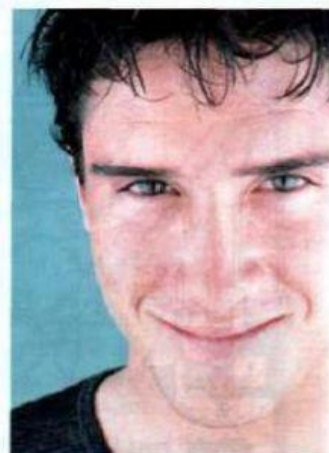

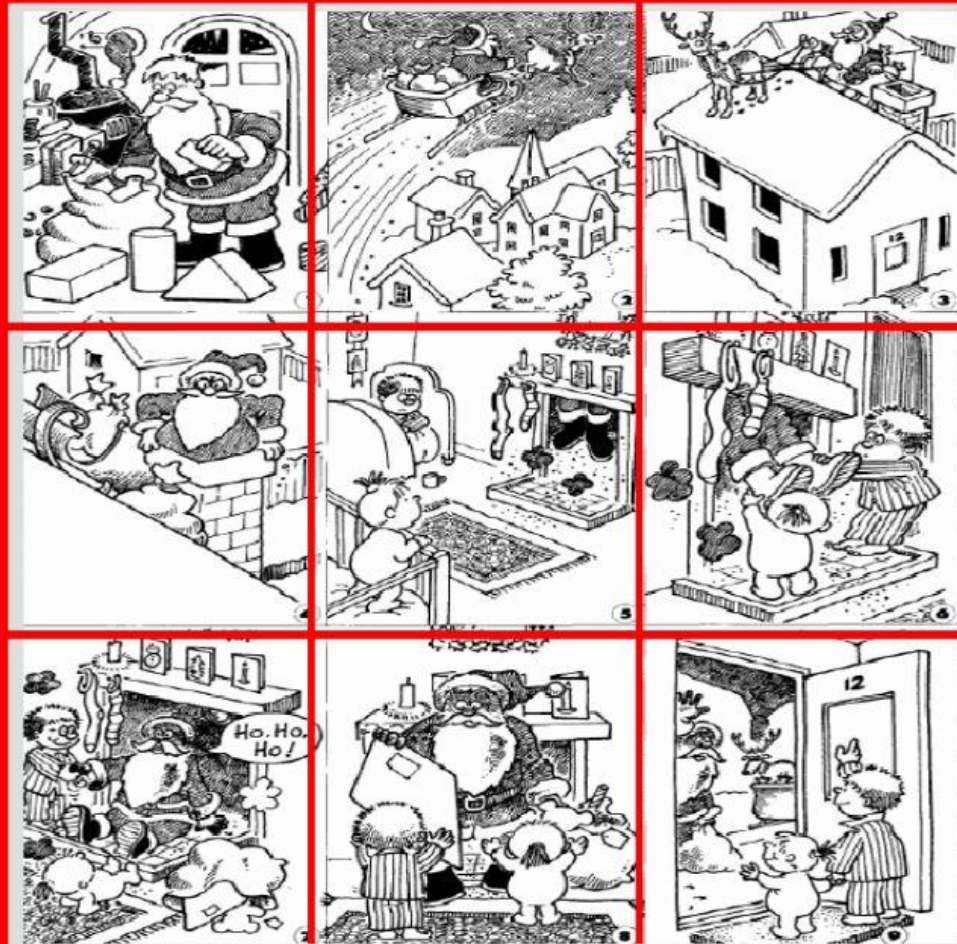
