Expressions or Linking words opinions are classified as follows:

- **Common phrases:** *I think...I believe...I feel...In my opinion... and I would say...*
- **Add strength:** *I really think, I strongly believe, I truly feel, or in my honest opinion...*
- **Formal phrases:** *From my point of view, from my perspective, In my view, or it seems to me that...*
- **Asking for opinions:** *What do you think of? What are your thoughts on? How do you feel about...? And What's your opinion on...?*
- **Agreeing & disagreeing:** *So do I, Me too, Definitely. I agree. Or I couldn't agree more.*
