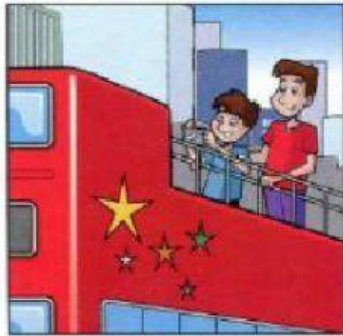


What did Jack do last week?

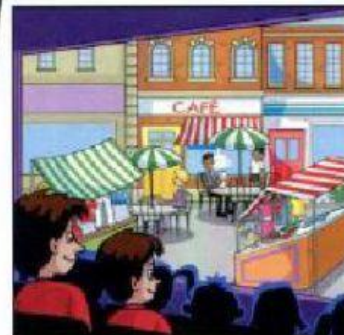
