1 Read and learn

There are two kinds of letters in the alphabet:
vowels and consonants. Vowels are A, E, O, I, U.
All the other letters are consonants.

The letter Y is a tricky letter, because sometimes it
is a vowel and sometimes it is a consonant.

In the end of **one syllable** words Y says /ai/

In the end of **long words** Y says /i/

Y is consonant /j/ in the **beginning of words**.
