AFFIRMATIVE



Subject + verb to be + verb with -ing + complement

Anna (she) is studying for her exams

Marcos and I (we) are swimming in the pool

NEGATIVE

Subject + verb to be + not + verb with -ing + complement

I am not eating my lunch

Irma and Peter are not cooking a steak



INTERROGATIVE



Normally we put the verb to be first, but there are cases where we want to know **HOW** (cómo), **WHERE** (dónde), **WHEN** (cuando), **WHAT** (qué) and **WHY** (por qué) something is happening. We call these "Wh-Questions"

Verb to be + subject + verb with -ing + complement + ?

Are you competing in the tournament?

WH- question + verb to be + subject + verb with -ing + complement + ?

What is Julian doing with a pencil?
