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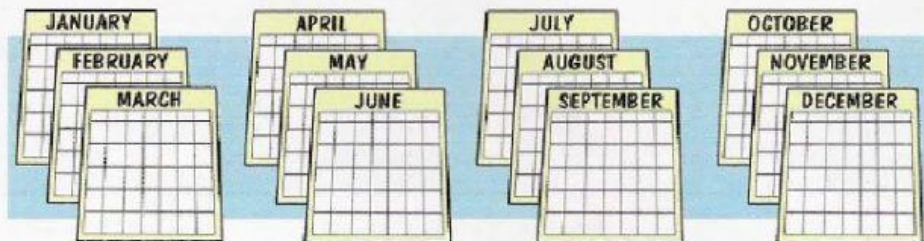

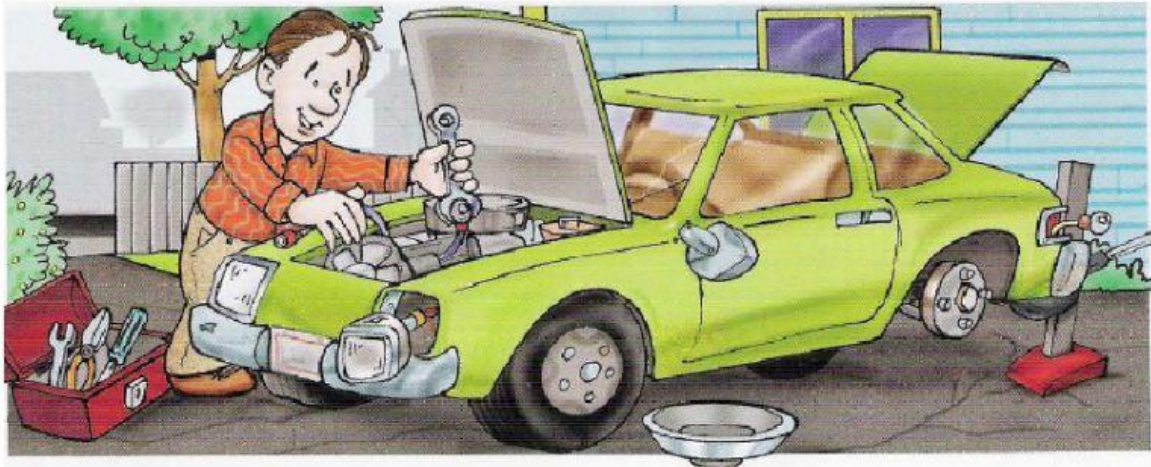

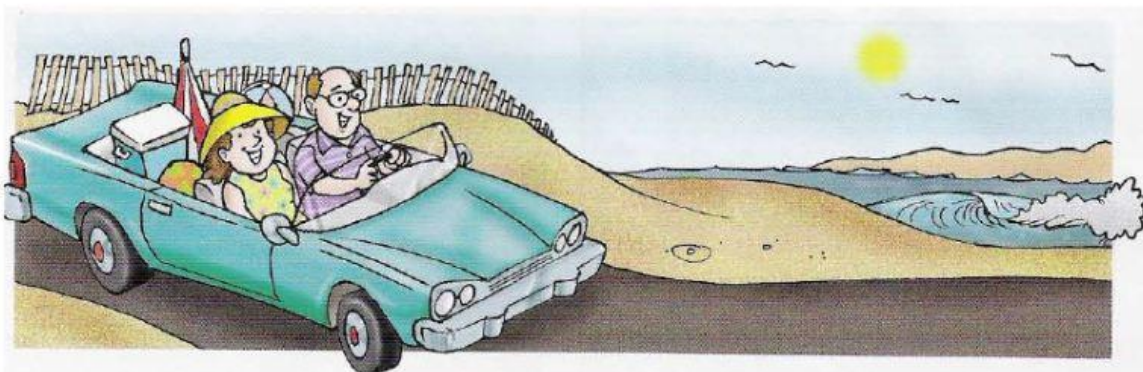
We're going (to go) swimming. = { We're going swimming.
