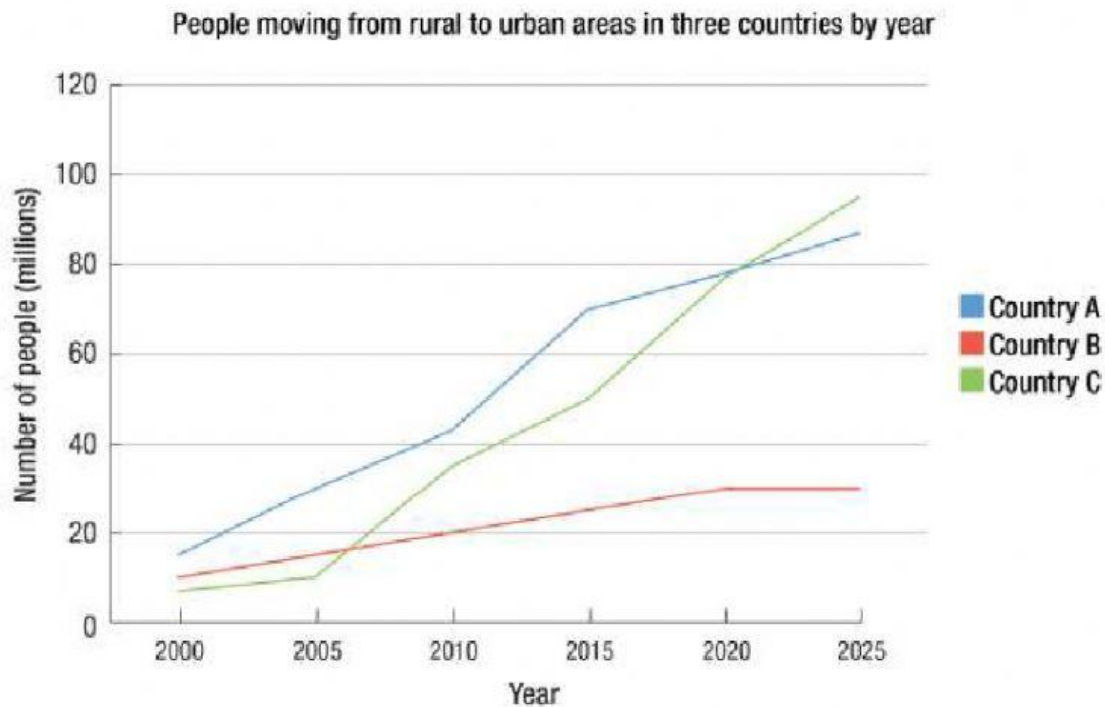


Exercise 7
