The Xylophone

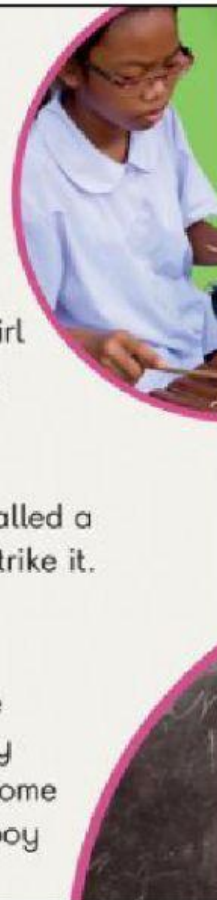
A **xylophone** has wooden bars. The girl is striking the xylophone with mallets.
