PRESENT OR FUTURE CONDITION

2nd conditional

PAST RESULT

3rd conditional

If + subject+ past simple + , + subject + would have + participle

If I were rich, I would have bought that house last year.

(=I'm not rich)

(=I didn't buy that house)

If I were organized and kept a diary...

If I didn't know her name...

If I weren't so busy on Friday night...

If I loved sports and ran everyday...

If I had more money...

If I believed in myself and weren't so shy...

If I you spent more time with us...

I would have bought a better present for her

I would have invited you to our party

I would have remembered that I had a date

I would have sang in front of everybody

I would have asked my friends

I would have gone to the movies with you

I would have participated in the competition
