# SIMPLE

## AFFIRMATIVE

Kim **will be** back soon.

subject + will + verb (infinitive)

## NEGATIVE

Kim **will not** be back soon.  
**won't**

## INTERROGATIVE

**Will Kim be** back soon?

will + subject + verb (infinitive)

## PREDICTION

**People will colonize** the moon in 2030.

### Used with:

tonight, next week, tomorrow, in 50 years, in the future, in 2070, by the year 3020, when I'm old, one day...

**Used with:** I think, I'm sure, I hope, probably, perhaps, definitely

## PROMISES

I will (or: I'll) take the dog for a walk. I promise!

I will not (or: won't) be late again!

## SPONTANEOUS Decision

I think I will (or: I'll) cook pasta for dinner.

### Used with:

I think, I don't think, I believe...

## OFFERS

I will (or: I'll) open the window for you.

## REQUESTS

Will you open the door for me, please?

## THREATS/WARNINGS

Be quiet or I will tell mum about your lousy test!

## INTENTION

I will do my homework later. Now I need to rest.

## REFUSAL

He won't listen to anyone. He is very stubborn!

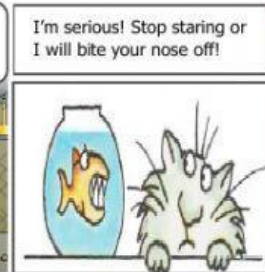
