

Exercise 9

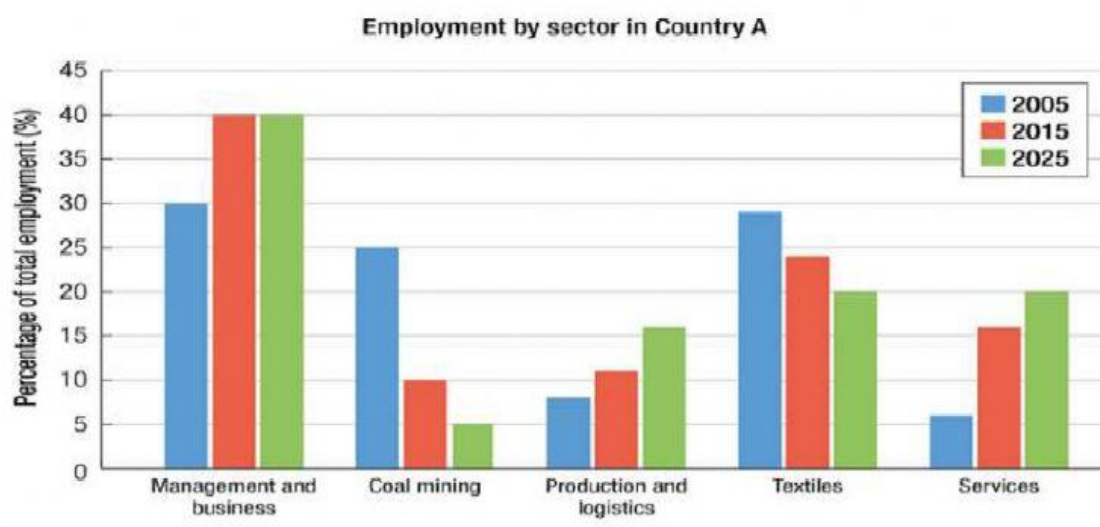
Read the information. Then read the summary paragraphs of the data shown in the chart. Do they include inaccurate, inappropriate or irrelevant information? Choose the correct responses.

Remember that in order to achieve a higher band, it is important that your essay does not include any inaccurate, inappropriate or irrelevant information.

- *inaccurate*: uses information which is incorrect based on the data presented in the chart
- *inappropriate*: uses informal or colloquial language that you wouldn't typically see in an academic piece of writing
- *irrelevant*: contains information which isn't presented in the chart

The bar chart below shows the total percentage of people employed in different sectors of the economy in Country A in 2005 and 2015 with projections for 2025.

Summarise the information by selecting and reporting the main features, and make comparisons where relevant.



1. To summarise, more people were working in management over the period shown and this trend is expected to continue. Whilst those employed in the coal mining and textile sectors will both decrease dramatically and those involved in services and production and logistics will remain roughly the same. inaccurate/ inappropriate/ irrelevant

In conclusion, there are many more graduates in financial subjects now, so it stands to reason that there will be more people working in the area of management and business in future years in comparison to the other sectors of the economy such as coal mining. inaccurate/ inappropriate/ irrelevant
