Yes, the simplest way there is to do that is by using the "startup"¹ folder in the Start menu. There are several ways you can add programs to the list of programs that load at startup. The easiest way is this:



1. There is a folder called Startup where there are direct access links to all the programs that load automatically. This folder is in C:\Documents and Settings\All Users\Startup Menu\Programs\Startup.
2. Make a direct access link to your program, then move it to this folder.
