Weight: 250 kg
Length: 2 metres

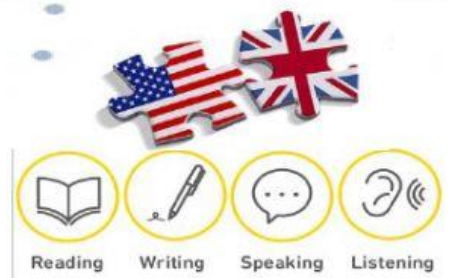

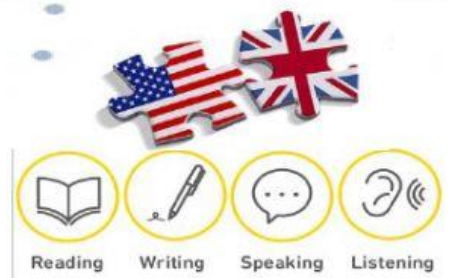
