Look at the flow-chart and the recording script. Choose the correct letter, A, B or C.

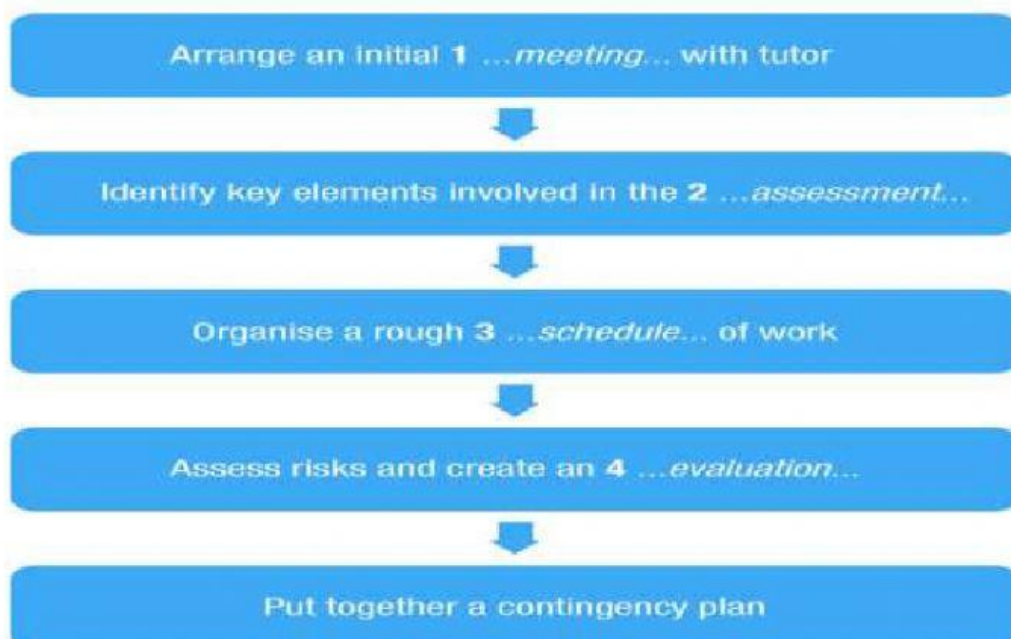
