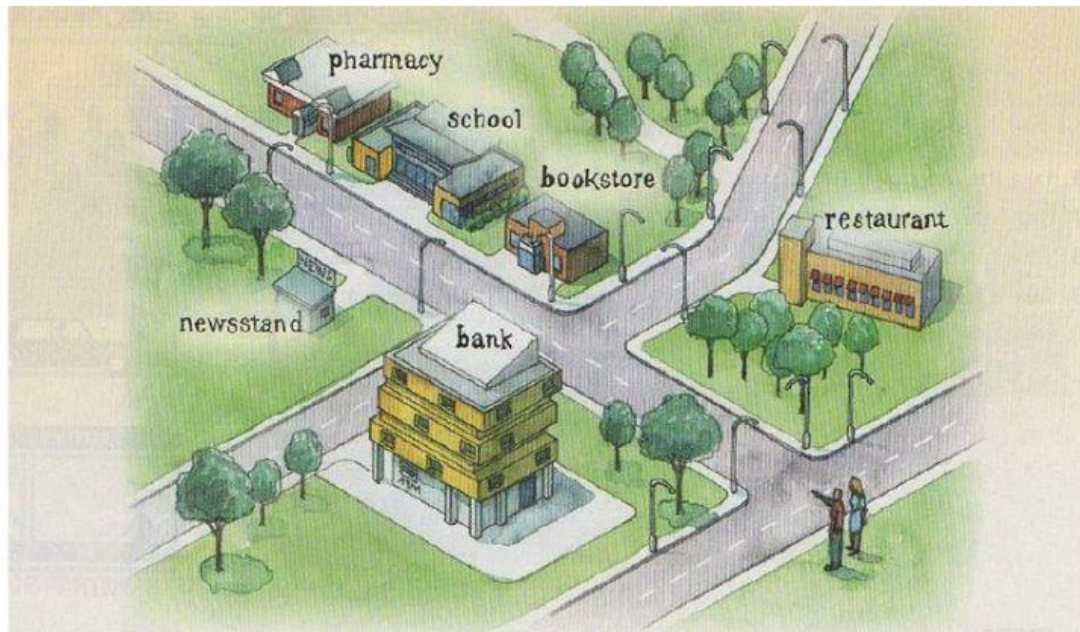

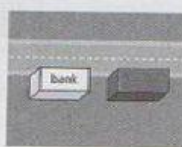


Where's the school?	It's across the newsstand

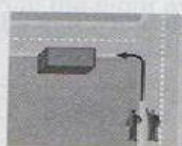
