1. To talk about an action or situation in the past which is finished. We often say when it happened.

I studied German for 2 years.

2. Chronological activities in the past.

Today, I woke up at 5 am, I took a shower, I brushed my teeth, and dressed up.

Time expressions:

- yesterday
- in the morning
- in 1963
- two days ago
- this morning
- last year

 + verb past + rest +) I sang in the shower this morning. +) She went to the park yesterday.	PRESENT (infinitive)	PAST
	sing	sang
	go	went
	need	needed
 + did not + verb simple form + rest. -) I did not sing in the shower this morning. -) She didn't go to the park yesterday. (did not = didn't)	travel	travelled
Did +  + verb s.f. + rest? ?) Did I sing in the shower in the morning? Yes, I did. / No, I didn't. ?) Did she go to the park yesterday? Yes, she did. / No, she didn't.		
Why did I go to the park yesterday? Because my dog needed to go to the park. Where did you go yesterday? I went to the park.
