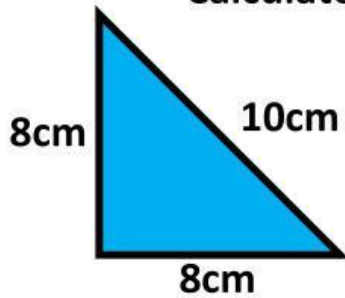


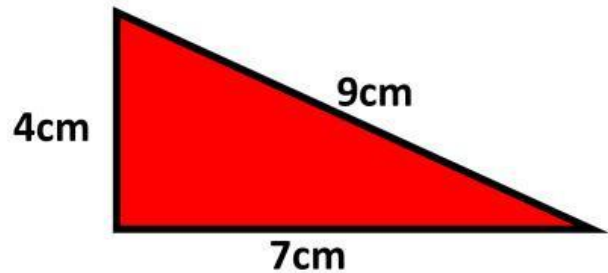
Area and Perimeter of Triangles

Calculate the area and perimeter of these triangles



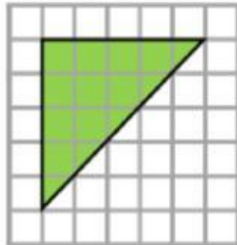
Perimeter = cm

Area = cm^2



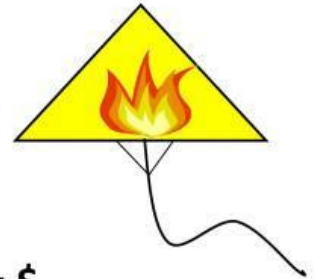

How much will he pay?



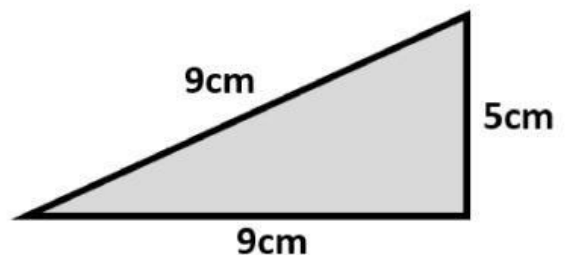
