#### THE FRENCH QUARTER IN NEW ORLEANS

**1** New Orleans is not a typical city. The combination of people from many cultures<sup>1</sup> makes it special. The French began to build the city 300 years ago, and then the Spanish arrived. New Orleans became part of the United States in 1803. Many people came as slaves from Africa, and many became free by 1868. The French Quarter, a very old area of New Orleans, is very special today because it shows the combination of these cultures.

**2** The French Quarter is a very small area, but there is a lot to see, eat and do. At breakfast time in the market many people wait at the Café de Monde. They want to order the famous doughnuts, *beignets*, with their cups of coffee. A popular French candy is a *praline*. This is a candy with nuts. In and around the market there are 20 different candy stores. Each one sells *pralines*.

**3** From the market you can hear the sound of drums and trumpets. Musicians perform on the street in all areas of the French Quarter. There are many styles of music in New Orleans, but the most popular is jazz. The African-Americans of New Orleans were the first people in the world to play jazz.

**4** A short walk away, you can board a steamboat<sup>2</sup> and travel along the Mississippi River. Today there are trains, cars and planes, but in the past steamboats were a great way to bring passengers and goods<sup>3</sup> to and from New Orleans.

**5** With great food, lots of music and many things to do, it is easy to see why almost ten million people travel to New Orleans each year.
