SARANGI

The sarangi, also called the saran, is a traditional instrument from Nepal. The word sarangi means "a hundred colors", which refers to the many sounds produced by this instrument. The sarangi is a stringed instrument made of wood with three main strings. It is played with a bow like a violin. The sarangi is played by the Garndarbha people. In the past, the Garndarbha travelled from village to village, singing about heroes, battles, and the stories of people they met on their journey. In modern Nepali music, the sarangi is one of the most famous instruments. Nepali folk bands feature popular modern sarangi players, encouraging young musicians to learn this traditional instrument.
