STRING INSTRUMENTS

WIND INSTRUMENTS

Recorders and flutes are wind instruments. The musician blows air into the flute to make music. Do you like it? Do you know how to play them?

PERCUSSION INSTRUMENTS

This is a xylophone. The musician hits it with sticks. Xylophones and drums are percussion instruments. Do you like it?
