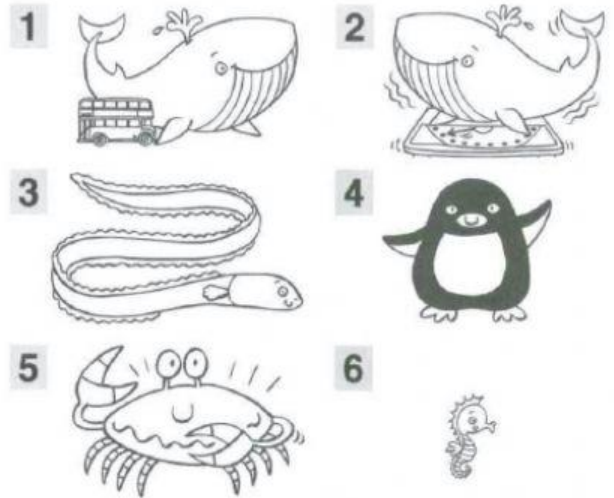

Penguin

Seahorse

A seahorse is a fish, but it can't live in cold water.

It's got a beautiful head, a thin body and a tail, but it hasn't got any legs.

It's a very slow swimmer and it hardly ever moves.

A seahorse can hold onto a plant with its tail.

Starfish

A starfish isn't a fish. It lives on the ocean floor.

It's got a hard body and hundreds of tube feet on its arms.

It can't swim so it walks on the ocean floor.



Fun fact!

A starfish can make itself a new arm!

Whale

A whale is a mammal and it lives in the ocean.

It's very long, heavy and loud. It's longer than three buses, heavier than forty elephants and much louder than a lion. It can swim very long distances.

A whale only breathes air once every 90 minutes.
