

on: depend on, on the one hand, on the other hand, on+day/date etc.

at: at work, at the sea, look at, shout at, bark at, at the meeting, at the rehearsal, at night, at midnight, arrive at +a place in a city etc.

in: in the middle of the night, in the morning, in the afternoon, in the evening, in the yard, in+ month/season/year, arrive in + a city/country etc.

of: the opposite of, take care of, afraid of etc.

to: move to, look forward to, listen to etc.

No preposition: all day, all night, all year, call smb, go home, go abroad, go downtown, last Monday, next week, every month etc.
