

THE CAUSATIVE

Look at the example and form causative sentences as in the example (using HAVE or GET in the appropriate tense): **have/get + object + past participle**

Example: The teacher is going to correct our exams next weekend.

We are going to have / get our exams corrected next weekend.

Use GET in this case, but remember that you can change it for HAVE

- 1) Is anyone going to remove that wasps' nest for us?
- 2) The local supermarkets deliver the food to our neighbours every day.
- 3) The mechanic is repairing Kathy's car at the moment.
- 4) An electrician has installed a solar powered heater on your roof
- 5) A trash collector collects our rubbish once a week.
- 6) A man is changing the lights in their house to a more environmental friendly ones.
- 7) Amazon has delivered our new garden furniture today.
- 8) The mechanic didn't service my car last year.
- 9) An optician has tested my eyes recently.
- 10) A gardener is planting a lemon tree in your garden.
- 11) A hairdresser cuts Susan's hair every month.
- 12) A dry cleaner will clean this suit after the party.
- 13) A decorator painted our flat last week.
- 14) A builder is going to mend my mum's roof.
- 15) The local council has pedestrianised this street.
